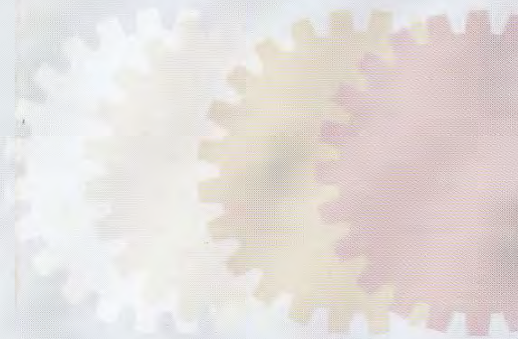

Bangladesh Small and Cottage Industries Corporation

Bangladesh Small & Cottage Industries Corporation (BSCIC) is the prime mover organization entrusted with the responsibility of development of small and cottage industries (SCI) in Bangladesh. It is a Govt. autonomous body under the Ministry of Industries and was established by an act of the Parliament in 1957.



Functions

At present BSCIC is doing mainly three types of activities for extension and promotion of small, medium and cottage industries.

- Extensional & Promotional;
- Regulatory activities and
- Implementation of development projects under Annual Development Programme (ADP)

Extensional and Promotional Functions

- Entrepreneurship development ;
- Allotment of developed plots in Industrial Estates/ Industrial parks having all infrastructural facilities like road, water, electricity, gas etc ;
- Extend credit facilities to the entrepreneurs from its own fund and also through banks and financial institutions
- Preparation of Project Profile and Project Proposal and appraisal of project proposals;
- Provide technical and consultancy services for establishing new industrial units and quality improvement of SMCI products ;
- Development and distribution of new designs and prototypes ;
- Innovation and adaptation of appropriate technology in the SMCI sector ;
- Collect, Collate and dissemination of technical and other information leading to investment, production and marketing of SMCI products ;
- Conduct research, studies and survey in the SMCI sector & conducting training programmes;
- Other pre and post investment counseling .



Training Programme

Design Centre

At the BSCIC headquarter in Dhaka, BSCIC has a modern and well-equipped Design Centre. Different types of Product design of those that are innovated and supplied from this centre. The Design Centre also imparts training in the following trades :

- Block Print ■ Batik Print ■ Leather Works ■ Packaging
- Weaving/Tapestry ■ Cane, Bamboo and Wood Works
- Doll Making ■ Pottery/Ceramic ■ Metal/wood Inlay
- Jute handicrafts ■ Screen Printing ■ Fashion Design and
- Design Concept and Development.

Skill Development Centre (SDC)

BSCIC has 15 Skill Development Centres (SDC) in different parts of the country. The SDCs arrange training courses in the following trades :

- Electrical house wiring and motor winding ■ Refrigerator and Air-conditioner repairing ■ Manufacturing Garment Accessories ■ Fitting cum machine shop practices and welding pump ■ Computer (Office & Internet Browsing) ■ Shallow pump machine repairing ■ Repairing Electronic Goods
- Mobile phone repairing (Hardware & Software)

Small & Cottage Industries Training Institute (SCITI)

BSCIC has a training institute with boarding facilities at Uttara, Dhaka. It is known as the Small & Cottage Industries Training Institute (SCITI). It has following faculties to conduct training courses and research in the SCI sector ;

- Industrial Management ■ Financial Management
- Marketing Management ■ General Management
- Entrepreneurship Development.

Many more courses will be introduced soon.

BSCIC Computer Lab

To meet up the present demand of ICT manpower BSCIC established a well-equipped computer lab in Head Office, Dhaka. This lab provides computer and ICT training for BSCIC personnel from 2010. BSCIC

ICT Cell conducted the following courses:

- Computer Fundamentals ■ Hardware Troubleshooting ■ Internet & Networking
- e-filing ■ Online service ■ Automation & Use of software ■ Unicode & others



Credit Programme

For the promotion and extension of small, medium & cottage industries, BSCIC arranges credit facilities for the Entrepreneurs with the help of banks and other financial institutions. On the other hand BSCIC has some credit programme for the entrepreneurs to help poverty alleviation. These are:

- Self employment through small & cottage industries
- United Nations Capital Development Fund (UNCDF).

Salt Production

To make the country self sufficient in quality salt production and to ensure appropriate price for salt BSCIC provides various extension and promotion services to the salt growers. Under the assistance of BSCIC about 70000 acres of land in the coastal region of Cox'sbazar and Shatkhira districts has come under salt cultivation, where 45000 growers are directly engaged in salt production. The production of salt with the assistance of BSCIC in the last few years are as follows :

Moreover, BSCIC has provided 263 Salt Iodization Plants (SIP) to salt industrial units for mixing iodine in edible salt with the aim to remove iodine deficiency in human body. Implementation of Control of Iodine Deficiency Disorder through Universal iodization of Salt (CIDD) project is on going & 84 percent family of the country are now using iodized salt. The project will continue up to June 2016.

Bee-Keeping Programme

Under this program BSCIC helps the entrepreneurs in bee keeping and honey production by adopting modern and scientific methods. BSCIC has six permanent training centres and demonstration farms for bee keeping and honey extraction. The centres are located in 1) Badun, Pubail, Gazipur, 2) Kaunia, Barisal, 3) Bagmara, Lakhsham, Comilla, 4) Baserhat, Dinajpur, 5) Jatrapur, Bagerhat & 6) Thaukurermati, Fenchugonj, Sylhet.

Development of Small & Cottage Industries in Chittagong Hill Tract Region (CHT)

BSCIC has taken up the following programmes in the Chittagong Hill Tract Region (CHT) for promotion, extension and development of Cottage Industries through Training and Marketing facilities. These programme are 1) Cottage Industries Development Programme (CIDP), 2) Cottage & Rural Industries Development Programme (CRIDP) and 3) Socio Economic Development Programme. The training activities are being carried out in 32 permanent training centres of BSCIC in the CHT region.



Development of Small & Cottage Industries in Dahagram and Angarpota Region

BSCIC has a credit programme for the promotion of small and cottage industries in Dahagram and Angarpota Region through which the local inhabitants have access to credit for poverty alleviation and through small business and income generating activities.

Annual Development Programme (ADP)

BSCIC has been implementing a number of development projects in small and cottage industries sector in consistence with the aim and objectives laid in the national planning of the Government. For implementation of these projects, requisite amount of fund is being allocated under annual development programme (ADP) yearly . At present BSCIC is implementing 13 projects under ADP. These are :

Development projects of BSCIC under implementation Tannery Industrial Estate, Dhaka

Location of the
Project : Savar, Dhaka

Estimated Cost of the
Project : Taka 107871.00 lakh

Objective of Project
Implementation : To provide infrastructural facilities to the tannery entrepreneurs by establishing an environmentally suitably tannery estate for development and modernization of tannery industries with a view to attract foreign investment; increasing production; export; employment and enhancing contribution to GDP. The project is being implemented on 200 acres of land. Land for 155 industrial units on 205 plots are earmarked in this project, with the potential of creating employment opportunities for about 1 lac people. After implementation of the project, with shifting of all tannery units from Hazaribagh area.



Dhaka Metropolitan City and the river Buriganga will be free from the cause a major environmental pollution.

Infrastructural works like internal roads, drains & culverts, street light, electricity & water supply etc. is already completed. Administrative building, police fari, fire service unit, pump driver's quarter has also been set up in the project site. A common Effluent Treatment Plant (CETP) and waste Dumping Yard is under construction.

Active Pharmaceutical Ingredients (API) Industrial Park

Location of the Project : Baushia, Gajaria, Munshigonj.

Estimated Cost of the Project : Taka 43905.76 lakh

Objective of Project Implementation : To establish an environmentally suitable Industrial Park to produce Active Pharmaceutical Ingredients. The project is being implemented on 200 acres of land. There will be 42 nos. of plots in which 42 nos. of Pharmaceutical Ingredients Manufacturing Industrial units will be set up. About 25,000 people will get employment opportunities through the project. Infrastructural facilities including Common Effluent



Treatment Plant (CETP) and waste Dumping Yard will be available in this project. At present, land development and other infrastructural works is going on.

BSCIC Industrial Estate, Mirsarai

Location of the Project : Mirsarai, Chittagong.

Estimated Cost of the Project : Taka 2495.00 lakh

Objective of Project

Implementation : The project is being implemented on 15.32 acres of land .There will be 88 nos. of developed plots in which 88 small and medium industrial units will be set up. Infrastructural works such as internal roads, drains & culverts, street light, electricity, gas & water supply, rain water and solar panel will be available in this project. About 5,000 people will get employment opportunities through this project. At present, land development and other infrastructural work is going on.



Gopalganj Industrial Estate, Extension

Location of the Project : Gopalganj

Estimated Cost of the Project : Taka 7430.00 lakh

Objective of Project

Implementation : The project will create industrial plots, with the development of infrastructure, such as internal roads, drain & culvert, street light, water supply in the designated area to establish small & medium industries by entrepreneurs. The project is being implemented on 50 acres of land. There will be 377 nos. of developed plots in which 250 small and medium industrial units will be set up. About 25,000 people will get employment opportunities through this project. At present, land development and other infrastructure work is going on.

Industrial Estate Comilla-2

Location of the Project : Debidwer Upazila of Comilla district

Estimated Cost of the Project : Taka 6890.00 lakh

Objective of Project

Implementation : The project will develop basic infrastructure for industrial plots, such as internal roads, drain & culvert, street light, water supply the designated area to establish small



& medium industries by private entrepreneurs. The project is being implemented on 20 acres of land. There will be 162 nos. of developed plots in which 100 small and medium industrial units will be set up. About 5000 people will get employment opportunities through this project.

Special Economic Zone, Kumarkhali, Kushtia.

Location of the Project : Kumarkhali, Kushtia

Estimated Cost of the Project : Taka 1364.00 lakh

Objective of Project

Implementation : The project is being implemented on 10 acres of land. All infrastructural works, like internal roads, drains & culvert, street light, electricity and water supply, rain water preserver, solar panel and a Common Effluent Treatment Plant (CETP) etc. will be available there. There will be 68 nos. of developed plots in which 30-35 small and medium textile industrial units will be established. Which will contribute of the growth of the GDP. About 2000 people will get employment opportunities after completion of this project.



BSCIC Industrial Park, Sirajgonj

Location of the Project : Saidabad and Kalia Horipur of Sirajgonj Sadar Upazila

Estimated Cost of the Project : Taka 48996.00 lakh

Objective of Project Implementation : The project will provide the revitalization of rural economy, specially in the northern region of the country, through establishing an Industrial Park, within 400 acres of land. 570 small and medium industrial units will be set up, in its 801 developed plots. Infrastructure, utilities and facilities such as internal roads, drainage, culvert, street light, electricity, water supply, banks, common bonded warehouse, customs clearance trade logistic, networked building, internet service, conference centre, fire station, security facilities, consulting services, medical centre, product exhibition area, child care facilities, dormitory, post office and commercial centre will be available in this industrial park. About one lac people will get employment opportunities after completion of the project. At present, land development and other infrastructure work is going on.



Control of Iodine Deficiency Disorder through Universal Iodation of Salt (CIDD)

Location of the Project : The project activities are operated throughout the country by 64 district offices(ISC) of BSCIC. Project Headquarter is located in Dhaka. 8 zonal offices are Dhaka Metro, Chittagong Metro, Khulna Metro, Narayengonj, Chandpur, Patiya, Cox'Bazar and Jhalokhati.

Estimated Cost of the Project : Taka 7100.00 lakh

Objective of Project

Implementation : To increase production and supply of adequately iodized salt as per requirement of the population; to provide legislative support; to make iodization of edible salt mandatory; to create demand for adequately iodized salt by the consumers; to ensure sustainable business plan for procurement supply and utilization of potassium iodate. Moreover, the project has provided 263 Salt Iodations Plant (SIP) to Salt Industrial units for mixing iodine in salt with the aim to eradicate goiter. Due to the implementation of CIDD project 84 percent household of the country are now using iodized salt.



Industrial Estate, Borguna

Location of the Project : Borguna Sadar

Estimated Cost of the Project : Taka 708.00 lakh

Objective of Project

Implementation : The project is being implemented on 10.21 acres of land. There will be 61 nos. of developed plots in which 61 small and medium industrial units will be set up. About 2200 people will get employment opportunities in the project. At present, land acquisition programme of the project is going on.

Sreemangal Industrial Estate

Location of the Project : Sreemangal upazila, Moulvibazar district.

Estimated Cost of the Project : Taka 1990.00 lakh

Objective of Project

Implementation : The project is being implemented on 20 acres of land. There will be 130 nos. of developed plots, in which 90-100 small and medium industrial units will be set up . About 5000 people will get employment opportunities through this project. Land acquisition activities for the project is now going on.



BSCIC Industrial Estate, Bhairab

Location of the Project : Bhairab upazila sadar, Kishoregonj district.

Estimated Cost of the Project : Taka 5841.00 lakh

Objective of Project

Implementation : The project is being implemented on 40 acres of land. There will be 251 nos. developed plots, in which 251 small and medium industrial units will be setup. All infrastructural facilities like internal roads, drains & culverts, street light, electricity, gas & water supply will be available there. This project will create employment opportunity for about 38000 people. Land acquisition process for the project is activated.

Pabna Industrial Estate extension

Location of the Project : Pabna Sadar

Estimated Cost of the Project : Taka 39.43 lakh

Objective of Project

Implementation : The project is being implemented on 15 acres of land. On its 80 developed plots 80 small and medium industrial units will be setup here. Infrastructure facilities like internal roads, drains & culverts, street light, electricity, gas & water supply will be created by the project. So, about 4000 people will get employment opportunities through this project.



Development of Bee- Keeping through Modern Technology

Location of the Project : Activites to the project will be operated all over the country and experimental activities in 10 coastal districts (Chittagong, Cox'Bazar, Khulna, Barishal, Bhola, Pirojpur, Borguna, Patuakhali, Noakhali, Laxmipur).

Estimated Cost of the Project : Taka 936.00 lakh

Objective of Project Implementation : To develop bee-keeping through management of bee resource and bee plants; to increase agricultural products using appropriate technique of pollination; to meet the national demand of honey and to increase quality of production through modern technology. 6000 persons will receive entrepreneurship development training on bee-keeping from this project. about 12000 people will get employment opportunities when the project is completed.

Development of Satranji Shilpa, Rangpur

Location of the Project : Nishbetgonj and Radhakrishnapur, Rangpur

Estimated Cost of the Project : Taka 387.30 lakh

Objective of Project



Implementation : To develop Satranji Shilpa through skill development training for socio-economic development and poverty alleviation of the country. Production cum display centre is being constructed to increase production and to create market. About Tk. 200.00 lac will be disbursed among the artisans engaged in shatranji production as credit facilities and about 660 persons will be trained up for skill development under this project.

Information & Communication Technology (ICT) Activities

According to the vision 2021 BSCIC is implementing E-service based information technology services for the entrepreneurs of Small, Cottage & Medium Industries. BSCIC has taken necessary steps to provide services through its delivery outlet for the entrepreneurs. These are:

- Computerization of all departments of BSCIC Headquarter and field level offices with Computers and other ICT equipments.
- Setting up Computer network (LAN & WAN) for communication with its offices and service delivery outlets.
- For automation of activities BSCIC has developed and uses 4 customized softwares.
- To provide door-step services BSCIC has developed Online Service Delivery System.
- Development of dynamic and interactive website to provide information to the entrepreneurs .
- Established a Computer Lab at Head Office to provide IT based training for its personnel.

Institutional network

BSCIC has its institutional network dispersed throughout the country . Its Headquarter is located at Dhaka and 4 Regional offices are located at 1) Dhaka, 2) Chittagong, 3) Rajshahi and 4) Khulna respectively. There are District Industries Service Centre (ISC) in each of the 64 district. There are 74 Industrial Estates in different parts of the country. It has also 15 Skill Development Centres (SDC) in different parts of the country .



The centres are located at (1) BSCIC Electronic Complex, Mirpur in Dhaka (2) Satirpara in Narsingdi (3) Charipur in Feni (4) Shantush in Tangail (5) Ashoktola in Comilla (6) Gopalganj (7) Begumgonj in Noakhali. (8) Raipur in Laxmipur (9) Kaunia in Barishal (10) Sapura in Rajshahi (11) Pulhat in Dinajpur (12) Sayedpur in Nilphamary (13) Khadimnagor in Sylhet (14) Nandanpur in Brahmanbaria & (15) Hemayetpur in Pabna.
